- Built Programs of Work on weekly basis related to mowing, installing signs, fire pits, painting, splitting wood, and general up-keep of cabins and vault toilets, taking into consideration safety risks, and bear-safe work methods.
- Cleaned the 13 vault toilet facilities around the Hungry Horse reservoir bi-weekly, driving the 115-mile route and stopping at each facility to scrub the surfaces with citrus hospital cleaner, clean the risers with toilet bowl cleaner, then sweep, scrub and squeegee the floors with a bleach solution, then check and resupply toilet paper.
- Maintained developed recreation sites with a riding lawnmower that I maintained by sharpening the blades with a bench grinder and then tightening the blades with a socket wrench and refilling the grease inserts with a grease gun.
- Assisted the Wild and Scenic Rivers Crew to document wild animal populations, and river usage statistics as well as trash removal aboard a river raft with River Ranger.
- Worked with the Wilderness and Trails Crews to buck up trees with a crosscut saw and trim limbs with KATANABOY saws to clear and maintain the Marion Lake Trail.
- Constructed signage by measuring and then cutting plywood sheets with a table saw, painting the boards with Forest Service paint scheme, cutting the posts to the correct size with a miter table saw, and then attaching the sign to the post by drilling through the post with a hand drill and bolting the sign to the board.
- Installed multiple hand built signages around the Hungry Horse Reservoir with a shovel, pickaxe and Pulaski to dig the hole, and to ensure to sign was installed correctly, a tamping bar and level was used.
- Performed noxious weed removal with a weed-eater at developed and dispersed recreation sites, and the large warehouse and surrounding area.

- Replaced fire pits at developed recreation sites by digging out the old culvert fire pit with pickaxes, shovels and a tamping bar to insert the brand-new fire pit, updated to the newest specifications.
- Painted multiple U.S. Forest Service cabins, as a team with other interns, with U.S. Forest Service Paint scheme, using rectangle pads, brushes, and rolling pads.
- Maintained the U.S. Forest Service cabins by cleaning all surfaces with citrus hospital-grade cleaner, cleaning the flooring with Swiffer mops and checking the propane systems, tank levels, light filaments and replacing as needed.
- Split and hauled approx. twenty F-650 truckloads of wood using a hydraulic wood splitter that required using all PPE such as safety goggles, gloves and earplugs.
- Launched and trailered the River jet boat and then cleaned and maintained the dispersed recreation campsites on Hungry Horse Reservoir aboard the boat.

- Packed 100+ large cardboard boxes with belongings, and filled two 20' x 20' x 10' storage lockers.
- Clear Cut and removed tons of debris, including rock and stump removal from various properties with chainsaws, trucks and trailers.
- Removed damaged 100-year-old tree, 4' diameter, with gas and electric chainsaws, and cut tree limbs on a 40-foot extension ladder.
